Computers take some beating

TRANSOFT Corporation, with its offices at Sydney's Flemington Markets, has a range of computer programs designed for transport companies.

A spokesman for the company said the programs had been designed in consultation with owner-drivers, transport operations

personnel and transport accountants.

"A typical small fleet or single truck computer package costs less than the some of the paint and chrome jobs you see on the roads," he said.

"Yet it can virtually take over the role of an administration officer — which no small business can justify these days."

He said the Transoft system could "look after" consignment note records including proof of delivery slips.

It would also "track", give debtor and creditor information, advise on trip programming and monitor maintenance schedules — including

tyre records — and provide monthly profit and loss figures.

"That's just for starters," the spokesman said. "If you get bigger and need extra drivers, the computer will keep a complete file on all transactions."
